THE PROGRAM

LEADERSHIP SOUTH DAKOTA is open to all citizens of the state. Each year a new class of about 40 leaders is selected who represent the state from different geographic locations and public, private, and nonprofit sectors.

LEADERSHIP SOUTH DAKOTA sessions begin in September and conclude in March (six sessions plus a separate graduation date), visiting different communities across this great state, exposing participants to unique regions and local experiences, successes and challenges, and issues important to local leaders.



Timeline For Leadership South Dakota Application Process


